Course Syllabus

Course Overview:

Enhance the early childhood curriculum by creating play opportunities in the classroom. Explore options for embedding play in the classroom that are aligned with curriculum and supported by research. Implement checklists for observing and assessing play and acquire strategies to support students' academic and social emotional development. Participants develop a play-based activity based on research and reflect on the outcome in the early childhood classroom.

Course Learning Objectives:

- Examine and identify the value of play-based learning in early childhood education.
- Use rubrics and checklists to assess areas of play development in students.
- Design and implement classroom activities to encourage purposeful play in the classroom.

Module 2: Using Play for Socio-Emotional Growth		
Objective	Identify ways to teach empathy, collaboration, and a growth mindset through play.	
Activities and Needed Material	Reading Assignment: Chapters 4-6 of <u>Purposeful Play</u> by Mraz, Porcelli, and Tyler	
Assessment	Create a letter or handout to parents explaining the benefits of play for social emotional growth. Describe the strategies you will be using in the classroom to support and enhance social emotional development.	

Module 3: Using checklists to assess students' developmental needs in play	
Objective	Observe and assess students' developmental needs by using a checklist.
Activities and Needed Material	<p>Create an opportunity for students to play (could be outside, at developmental centers, or a learning through play opportunity).</p> <p>Choose a student to observe during the play opportunity, ideally you have concerns about the student's developmental needs or ability to play with others.</p> <p>Use the checklist provided in <u>Play: The Pathway from Theory to Practice</u> by Sandra Heidemann and Deborah Hewitt to observe and assess the student.</p> <p>Write a paragraph describing the developmental strengths and needs of the student.</p>
Assessment	Submit the completed checklist and paragraph.

Module 4: Create and reflect on a play opportunity	
Objective	<p>Implement a research-based play strategy.</p> <p>Reflect on effectiveness of the research based-play strategy used with students.</p>
Activities and Needed Material	<p>Reflect on the checklist from the previous module.</p> <p>Use the <u>Play: The Pathway from Theory to Practice</u> to determine a strategy to implement to develop a student's social, emotional, or cognitive skills through a play opportunity in an area of need identified through the checklist assessment.</p> <p>Implement the strategy with the student and observe student growth over a week.</p>
Assessment	<p>Write a 3-paragraph essay:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Explain the strategy implemented with the student and your rationale ● Describe what you observed from the student after you implemented the new strategy. ● Describe what your next step with this student will be and why.

Module 5: Plan for play-based learning opportunities in the early childhood classroom based on current thematic units	
Objective	Examine the themes or units in the curriculum that you use in your classroom. Create a plan for play-based learning based on the themes/units.
Activities and Needed Material	Examine the themes or units in the curriculum that you use. Create a long-range plan for incorporating play based learning activities and centers based on your themes and units (should include at least two activities/centers per month and incorporate literacy, math, social studies, and science skills)
Assessment	Submit your long-range plan.

Module 6: Create a play-based learning center/activity	
Objective	Develop and implement a play-based learning center/activity Provide rationale for including play-based activity/center within your students' learning.
Activities and Needed Material	Reflect on your long-range plans and select an activity to develop and implement with a class of students. Develop and implement the center/activity with a group or class of students. Write a 2-paragraph essay about your experience. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Why did you select the activity? ● What is your rationale for implementing this activity with this group of students? ● Reflection: Was the activity/center successful in meeting learning objectives for students? How could this be improved for future learning?
Assessment	Submit pictures of the center/activity and your 2-paragraph essay.

Module 7: Reflection	
Objective	Identify the importance of play in the early childhood education class. Identify ways to implement purposeful play in order to enhance student development and learning. Reflect on your experiences with play-based learning strategies.
Activities and Needed Material	Write a 2-page essay reflecting on the impact these tools will have in the classroom: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Why are these strategies important and relevant for your classroom? ● What do you feel would be the most impactful for your classroom? ● How can you use these strategies in your classroom to reflect a safe, caring, and supportive environment for all students? ● What will you do differently now to enhance student learning through play? ● Be sure to cite sources both in text and APA
